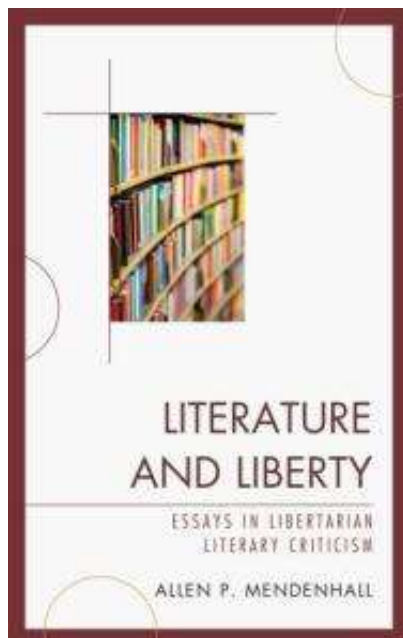

Allen Mendenhall is a writer, attorney, editor, speaker, and literary critic. As of January 2013, he is a staff attorney for Chief Justice Roy S. Moore of the Supreme Court of Alabama. He holds a B.A. in English from Furman University, M.A. in English from West Virginia University, J.D. from West Virginia University College of Law, and LL.M. in transnational law from Temple University Beasley School of Law. He is a Ph.D. candidate at Auburn University, where he received a Graduate Dean Fellowship. He is managing editor of the *Southern Literary Review* and has been an adjunct legal associate at the Cato Institute as well as a Humane Studies Fellow with the Institute for Humane Studies in Arlington, Virginia. He is a member of The Philadelphia Society and an associate of The Abbeville Institute. He is author of the book *Literature and Liberty: Essays in Libertarian Literary Criticism* (Rowman and Littlefield / Lexington Books, 2014).



He has studied at the University of London (Birkbeck College), the Shakespeare Institute of the University of Birmingham, Centro Universitario Vila Velha, Fundacao Getulio Vargas (Direito Rio), and the Tokyo campus of Temple University Beasley School of Law.

He is the author of over 100 publications in such outlets as law reviews, peer-reviewed journals, magazines, newspapers, literary journals and periodicals, and encyclopedias. He lives in Auburn, Alabama, with his wife, Giuliana, and two children.
